


A wet city located in a dry county.

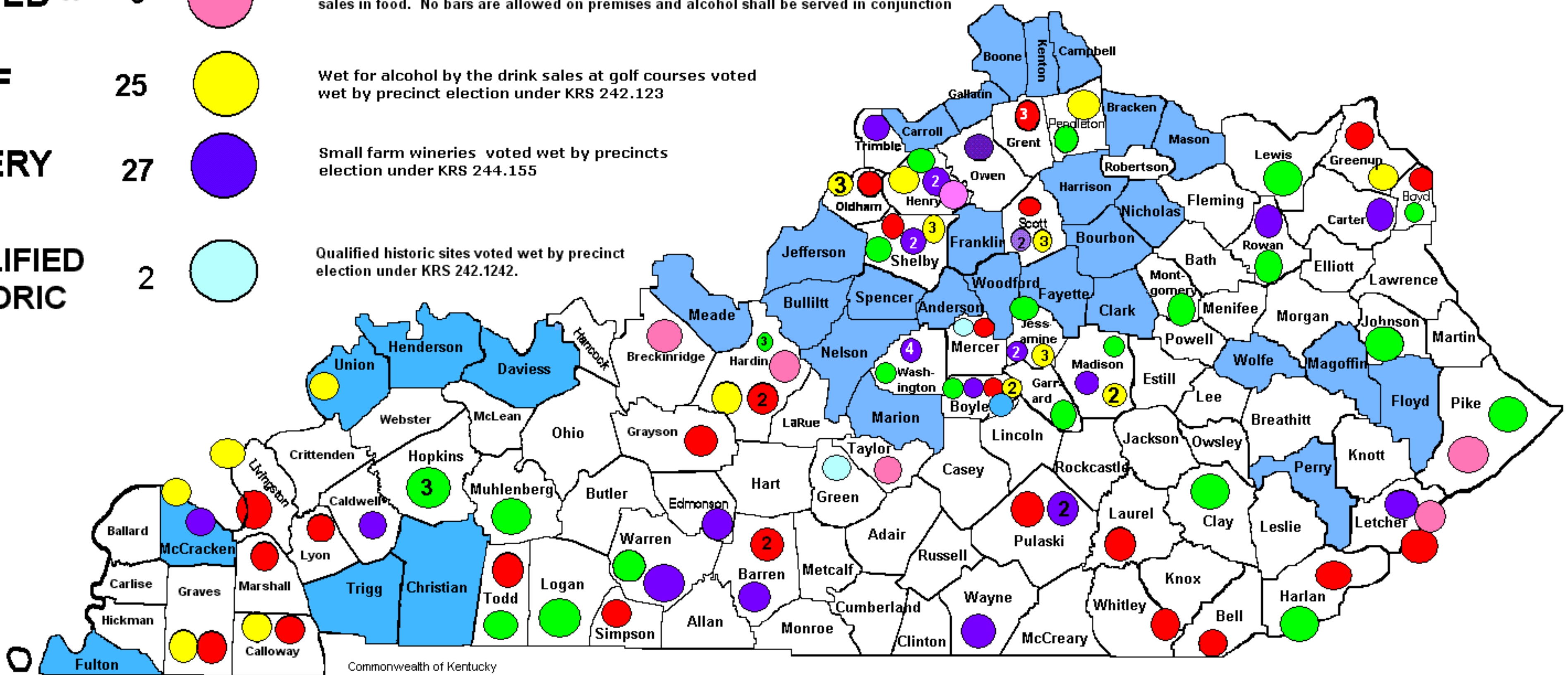
Wet for alcohol by the drink sales at golf courses voted wet by precinct election under KRS 242.123
