ORDINANCE NO. 451.18

AN ORDINANCE OF THE KENTON COUNTY FISCAL COURT AMENDING KENTON COUNTY ORDINANCE 451.13 ALLOWING RETAIL SALES OF PACKAGED LIQUOR ON SUNDAYS AND ESTABLISHING HOURS OF OPERATION THEREFOR, TO INCLUDE HOURS OF OPERATION FOR RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS SELLING LIQUOR BY THE DRINK, AND AUTHORIZING RETAIL SALES OF LIQUOR BY THE DRINK ON SUNDAY AND ESTABLISHING HOURS OF OPERATION THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 244.290, the Kenton County Fiscal Court may set reasonable hours of operation for those licensed to sell liquor by the package or drink throughout Unincorporated Kenton County, AND

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 243.050 the Kenton County Fiscal Court may allow licensees to apply for and obtain a Sunday retail drink license allowing those so licensed to operate during hours of operation set therefor within Unincorporated Kenton County, AND

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court has determined that such licensees located within Unincorporated Kenton County may operate between the hours of 12:00 P.M. and 2:30 A.M., Monday thru Sunday, AND

WHEREAS, the Kenton County Fiscal Court has determined that the hours of operation set forth herein fairly balance the interests of the public health, safety, and welfare, while also providing licensees a reasonable means to successfully operate their businesses, AND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fiscal Court, County of Kenton, Commonwealth of Kentucky, that:

Section 1.0 – Sale of Liquor

1.1 Package Liquor - The sale of package liquor by establishments holding a retail package license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, within the area subject to regulation by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, is permitted Monday thru Sunday, between the hours of 12:00 P.M. and 2:30 A.M.

1.2 Liquor by the Drink – Establishments holding a license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky for the retail sale of liquor by the drink, within the area subject to regulation by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, are permitted to operate between the hours of:

1.2.1 12:00 P.M. and 2:30 A.M., Monday thru Friday; and

1.2.2 12:00 P.M. and 11:59 P.M., Saturday.

1.2.3 Sunday Sales– Establishments holding a license for the retail sale of liquor by the drink within the area subject to regulation by the Kenton County Fiscal Court may operate between the hours of 12:00 PM and 2:30 A.M., Sunday upon issuance of a Sunday retail drink license by the Kenton County Treasurer or his designee.

Section 2.0 – License Required

2.1 Sunday Sales of Liquor by the Drink – Any establishment licensed to sell liquor by the drink by the Commonwealth of Kentucky that wishes to sell liquor by the drink on Sunday shall request a Sunday retail drink license from the Kenton County Treasurer or his designee.

2.1.1 Application – A prospective licensee shall submit a request for a Sunday retail drink license, including the name of the prospective licensee, the name of the establishment, its location, and a \$300.00 annual licensing fee to the Kenton County Treasurer or his designee.

2.1.2 Licensing Period – A Sunday retail drink license shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issue. Licensees in good standing shall have their licenses annually renewed upon receipt of the \$300.00 annual licensing fee by the Kenton County Treasurer or his designee.

2.1.3 Licensee to be in Good Standing – Licensees shall be considered not in good standing upon suspension or revocation of any retail liquor license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or by failing to remit the \$300.00 annual Sunday sales licensing fee.

2.1.4 Transferability – Licenses for Sunday sales of liquor by the drink shall be non-transferable.

Section 3.0 – Severability

3.1 The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provision thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 4.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.

ORDINANCE OF THE FISCAL COURT OF KENTON
COUNTY, KENTUCKY, PERMITTING THE SALE OF
PACKAGE LIQUOR ON SUNDAYS IN
UNINCORPORATED Kenton County

Whereas, the Sunday sale of alcoholic beverages is now permitted throughout most of Kenton County, Kentucky; and

Whereas, pursuant to KRS 244.290(3)(b) the Fiscal Court of Kenton County, Kentucky, has the authority to permit the sale of package liquor on Sundays; and

Whereas, other cities and counties throughout Northern Kentucky have acted to permit the sale of package liquor on Sundays.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

Section I

That the sale of package liquor by licensees holding a retail package license issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, within the area subject to regulation by the Kenton County Fiscal Court, Kentucky, is permitted on Sundays, between the hours of noon to midnight.

Section II

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on the 21st day of July, 2008.

ORDINANCE NO. 8, 2006

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION IV OF ORDINANCE NO. 1, 1973 REGARDING THE SPECIAL SUNDAY RETAIL DRINK LICENSE OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PARK HILLS, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section IV of Ordinance No. 1, 1973 to be amended as follows:

The Park Hills special Sunday retail drink license shall permit the holder to sell Distilled Spirits and wine during the hours from ~~1:00 p.m.~~ 10:00 a.m. to ~~midnight on Sunday~~ 2:30 a.m. Monday.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and/or amended.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and publication in accordance with KRS Chapter 424 and other applicable law.

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE SALE, POSSESSION OR DISPOSITION OF SPIRITUOUS OR VINOUS LIQUORS WITHIN THE CITY OF LOOKOUT HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY; PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR SAID BUSINESS AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF LOOKOUT HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, to barter, sell, transfer or in any manner engage in trafficking in spirituous or vinous liquors for consumption on the premises only, within the City of Lookout Heights, Kentucky, without having first paid to the City of Lookout Heights the license tax required by this ordinance and without having obtained the license required pursuant to the provisions hereof.

Section 2

No license for the sale of spirituous or vinous liquors at retail shall be granted for any premises, unless the applicant for such license be the owner thereof or be in possession of said premises under a written lease for a term not less than the license period.

Section 3

No premises shall be licensed for the sale of spirituous or vinous liquors at retail, except where the licensed premises and the entrance thereto are on the street level. Provided, however, that this provision shall not apply to a hotel, club or restaurant, where such hotel, club or restaurant, shall have been bona fide in business as a licensee in premises located above or below the ground floor for at least thirty (30) days preceding the date when application for a license is made under the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4

No person licensed to sell spirituous or vinous liquors at retail, shall cause, suffer or permit the licensed premises to be disorderly.

Section 5

A Retail Dispenser's License, when issued by the City of Lookout Heights, Kentucky, under authority of the Board of Trustees, shall permit its holder to sell at retail for consumption on the premises only, spirituous and vinous liquors.

The fee for such Retail Dispenser's License shall be One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.

The license period shall begin on July 1 of each year and terminate on the 30th day of June in the succeeding year. All license taxes shall be paid at any time during the month of June and before the 30th day thereof.

Section 6

Whenever any person, firm or corporation shall desire to engage in the business of retailing spirituous or vinous liquors in the City of Lookout Heights for consumption on the premises, such person, firm or corporation, shall first apply to the Board of Trustees of the City of Lookout Heights, Kentucky, by a written application for a license, which application shall set forth the name and residence of the applicant and that he is a person of good moral character and repute, which application shall be signed by the applicant and at least three (3) free-holders residing in

AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AND DISPOSITION OF SPIRITOUS, VINOUS OR MALT LIQUORS, WITHIN THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, KENTUCKY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE CITY OF FORT WRIGHT, KENTUCKY, :

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell or dispense or to offer to sell or dispense, spiritous, vinous or malt liquors, within the city of Fort Wright, Kentucky, without first having procured from the city as herein provided a license so to do and paying the fee prescribed therefor.

Section 2.

- (A) A retail dispensers Liquor license, when issued by the city of Fort Wright, Kentucky, shall authorize and permit its holder to sell at retail, vinous or spiritous liquors by the package for consumption off the premises. The fee for such license shall be \$100.00.
- (B) A Retail drink license, when issued by the city of Fort Wright, Kentucky, shall authorize and permit its holder to dispense and sell spiritous, and vinous liquors by the glass for consumption on the premises. The fee for such retail drink license shall be \$100.00.

All license issued hereunder shall permit the licensee to sell malt beverages for consumption on the premises in addition to spiritous and vinous liquors, without further fee.

Section 3.

A Malt Liquor License, when issued by the city of Fort Wright, Kentucky, shall authorize and permit its holder to sell and dispense Malt Liquors within the city of Fort Wright, Kentucky. The license fee therefor shall be \$100.00.

or other officer authorized to administer an oath, wherein shall be stated the applicants name; age; address and the exact location of the premises sought to be licensed, together with the name of the owner of said premises, with his written consent thereon endorsed, whereupon, if the Board of Trustees are satisfied that said license should be granted it may pass an order to that effect and thereupon the city clerk shall issue the license applied for, upon payment of the proper fee.

Section 4.

The provisions of the Kentucky State Alcoholic Control Act, in so far as the same are not in conflict herewith are hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance, by reference as fully as though copied herein and no person, firm or corporation, or premises who or which may be ineligible or disqualified from holding any permit or license pursuant to the provisions thereof, shall be eligible or qualified to receive or hold a license under the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5.

License issued pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance shall, while in force, be posted in a conspicuous place where liquors are kept for sale. Whenever a license shall become lost or destroyed without fault upon the part of the holder, a duplicate of the original shall be issued by the city upon the payment of a fee of \$1.00.

Section 6.

All money derived from the collection of license hereby imposed shall be covered into and become part of the general fund of the city of Fort Wright.

An ordinance amending ordinance No. 3 of 1942, imposing an annual license fee on all persons engaged in the business of selling for consumption on the premises any spirituous, vinous or malt liquor.

Whereas, at the regular meeting of May of 1942, the Board of Trustees passed and adopted an ordinance imposing an annual license fee on persons engaged in the business of selling for consumption on the premises any spirituous, vinous or malt liquor; and

Whereas, it is necessary to amend sections 2 and 3 thereof to conform to the Statutes of Kentucky; Now, therefore,

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Lakeside Park, Ky., do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Every person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of selling for consumption on the premises any spirituous, vinous or malt liquor shall pay an annual license fee or tax of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars to the Town of Lakeside Park for each place of business in said town.

Section 2. All licenses shall begin as of July 1st and expire as of June 30th of the following year.

Section 3. When any person shall apply for license hereunder after July 1st of any year, he shall be charged, if such license be granted, an amount equal to as many twelfths of the annual license tax as there are calendar months (including the months in which the license is granted) until the following July 1st; provided; that no license shall be issued for a shorter period than six months.

Section 4. Application for license shall be made to the Town Clerk, who shall issue license upon payment therefor, after such application shall have been approved by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees. No license shall be issued by the Clerk without the approval of the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
