AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CHANGING THE LICENSES AND FEES TO  
COMPLY WITH KRS 243.070, AS AMENDED BY SENATE BILL 13**

WHEREAS, KRS Chapter 243.070 was changed by Senate Bill 13 and therefore the licenses and fees issued and charged by the Fourth-Class city of Douglass Hills must be corrected,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS**

**Section 1:**

**Section 62.003 of the Codified Ordinance is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:**

**62.003 ISSUANCE OF LICENSE; RECEIPT OF FEES.**

All licenses granted under this chapter shall be approved and issued by the City ABC Administrator and shall be those fees authorized under KRS 243.070, set out below and as amended by Senate Bill 13. All license fees from licenses issued under this chapter shall be collected by the City ABC Administrator.

# CHAPTER 62: ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE REGULATIONS

## § 62.001 LICENSE REQUIRED

Within the city limits, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to do any act authorized by any alcoholic malt beverage, wine or distilled spirits license with respect to the manufacture, storage, sale, purchase, transportation or other traffic in alcoholic beverages unless he holds a license authorizing the act from the Commonwealth, the county, and the city.

The duties of the Alcoholic Beverage Commissioner shall be discharged by the City Clerk as set out in § 21.002.

**§ 62.999 PENALTY**

(A) Any person who, by himself or acting through another, directly or indirectly violates any of the provisions of this chapter for which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined, for the first offense, not less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars nor more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars, or shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than six months, or both. For the second and subsequent violations, any person violating the provisions of this chapter where no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined no less than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars nor more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, or shall be imprisoned in the county jail for not more than six months, or both. Each sale in violation of this chapter shall constitute a separate offense.

ORDINANCE NO. 4, SERIES 1982

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES 1982 AND RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1. Within the corporate limits of the City of Douglass Hills, Kentucky, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to do any act authorized by any alcoholic malt beverage or wine license with respect to the manufacture, storage, sale, purchase, transportation or other traffic in alcoholic beverages unless he holds the kind of license that authorizes such act from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, County of Jefferson and City of Douglass Hills.

Section 2. The following kinds of distilled spirits and wine licenses may be issued by the City, the fees for which shall be:

Section 3. The following kinds of malt beverage licenses may be issued by the City, the fees for which shall be:

- [a] Brewer's license,

Section 4. The City Alcoholic Beverage Administrator shall issue a Special Sunday sale retail drink license to any person who holds a license to sell liquor or wine at retail by the drink, and who is otherwise qualified for such license by the provisions of KRS Ch. 243 and KRS 244.290(4).

Section 5. The business authorized by the licenses provided for herein shall correspond to the business authorized by the corresponding licenses authorized by and KRS Chapter 243 and KRS Chapter 446 and specifically including the definitions contained in KRS 446.010.

Section 6. Any person who, by himself or acting through another, directly or indirectly, violates any of the provisions of this ordinance for which no other penalty is provided, shall for the first offense, be fined not less than One Hundred (\$100) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars, or be imprisoned in the County jail for not more than six months, or both; and for the second and each subsequent violation, he shall be fined not less than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, or be imprisoned in the County jail for not more than six months, or both. Each sale in violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense. Penalties provided for herein shall be in addition to the revocation or suspension of the offender's license.

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective when published according to law.
